The General Prosecutor of the United Nations Transitional Administration for East Timor, pursuant to his authority under UNTAET Regulations 1999/1, 2000/11, 2000/15, 2000/16 and 2000/30 charges:

Carlos Soares Carmone

with

Murder

as set forth in this indictment.

II. Name and Particulars of the Accused

Name : Carlos Soares Carmone
Age : 36 years; DOB 15/08/1962
Place of Birth : Aulau, Hatolia, Ermera
Nationality : East Timorese.
Location : Gleno Prison

III. Statement of the Facts

1. On or about 28 May 1999 in the village of Asulau, District of Ermera, Carlos Soares Carmone went to the house of Constantinho and forcefully took him into custody.
2. On or about 28 May 1999, in the village of Asulau, District of Ermera, Carlos Soares Carmone, with others, tied up Constantinho in the house of Nicolas Araujo.
3. Constantinho was beaten after being tied up. While he was tied up, and after he was beaten, Carlos Soares Carmone then stabbed Constantinho.
4. Constantinho died as a result of his injuries.

IV. Statement of the Offence

Pursuant to the above the Prosecutor charges:


COUNT 1:

On or about 28 May 1999 in the village of Asulau, subdistrict of Haolia, District of Ermera, the Accused Carlos Soares Carmone did, with deliberate intent and with premeditation, commit, aid, abet or otherwise assist in the murder of **Constantino** in violation of Section 8 UNTAET Regulation 2000/15 and Article 340 of the Penal Code of Indonesia.

The list of witnesses and evidence that supports this indictment is contained in Annex A which forms an integral part of this indictment.

The Prosecutor requests that the Special Panel on Serious Crimes of the District Court of Dili to take jurisdiction of this matter expeditiously.
